

A-15 ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORTING TO THE PUBLIC

The Board of School Trustees accepts its responsibility to lead in the identification and development of broad goals and specific objectives to be accomplished by the school district and to make realistic adjustments in these targets. In return, the Board will expect the superintendent to employ all appropriate means to provide for continuous and candid reports of the accomplishment by staff in the pursuit of these goals and objectives for which reliable measurement indicators have been established.

The purpose of these accomplishment reports shall be to provide the Board with information needed for making policy and planning decisions and to keep the public informed about school needs and about actual results being obtained from the public's support of school programs.

Accomplishment reports should be presented as necessary in order that the significance of all information may be easily understood by lay citizens. These reports should also be accompanied by administrative recommendations for Board consideration and action.
