

A-9 FUTURE PLANNING

Members of the Board of School Trustees recognize the increasing complexity of the management of the school system and the consequent need to expand the formal planning process beyond the traditional one school year basis. Planning will consist of, but not be limited to, the following elements:

1. Student enrollment data and projections
2. A curricular review and an analysis of programs' strengths and weaknesses
3. Space utilization and physical facility needs
4. Income and expense estimates
5. A list of priorities to be accomplished and a proposed timeline for accomplishment
6. A communications system to keep the public informed on current and anticipated developments

As an ongoing portion of the Board's involvement in future planning, periodic reviews and assessment will be made and appropriate revisions made on an annual basis.

Through this technique, a better quality program should be available to the students of the school community.
