

B-14 BOARD ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING

The Board of School Trustees of the Plainfield Community School Corporation shall meet within the first fifteen days of January each calendar year and organize. The governing body shall organize by electing from its membership a president, two (2) vice-presidents, and a secretary, each of whom shall be a different member. The president shall appoint a parliamentarian.

The Board shall also fix their compensation for their services and appoint a Treasurer of the governing body and of the school corporation at this meeting. The treasurer must be a person other than the Superintendent and cannot be a member of the governing body. The amount of the Bond for the Treasurer shall be established at this time.

Members of the Board of School Trustees shall be reimbursed for expenses while attending conventions, workshops, or meetings of the Indiana School Boards Association, National School Boards Association, or other professional organizations, and for travel expenses related to School Board duties.
