

B-23 QUORUM

Under the General School Powers Act, a quorum is a simple majority of the total membership of the Board. Except where a majority vote of the total Board is required by law, a majority of the members present may adopt a resolution or take any action if a quorum is present.

Under Indiana law, a majority of the full Board must vote to approve any contract.
