

B-29 BOARD POLICY DEVELOPMENT

It is the intent of the Board of School Trustees to develop policies and put them into writing, so that they may serve as goals and guidelines for the successful and efficient functioning of the Plainfield Community School Corporation. The Board, representing the people of the district, is the legislative body which determines all questions of general policy to be employed in the conduct of the public schools. The Board considers policy development as one of its chief functions, along with providing the needed essentials, such as personnel, facilities, materials, and equipment for the successful administration, application, and execution of its policies.

It is the Board's intention that its policies serve as sources of information and guidance for all people who are interested in or connected with the school district. The policies are framed, and are meant to be interpreted, in terms of Indiana statute, rules and regulations of the Indiana Department of Education, and all other regulatory agencies within the local, state, and federal levels of government.

Changes in needs, conditions, purposes, and objectives will require revisions, deletions, or additions to the policies of present and future Boards. The Board will welcome suggestions for ongoing policy developments.
