

B-41 NEW BOARD MEMBER ORIENTATION

The magnitude of School Board membership calls for knowledge of and orientation to many areas of information and understandings. Under the guidance of experienced Board members and the Superintendent of Schools, orientation will be provided to new Board members through activities such as these:

1. Workshop for new Board members conducted by the Indiana School Boards Association.
2. Discussions and visits with the Superintendent of Schools and other members of the school staff.
3. Provision of printed and audio-visual materials on School Board policies and procedures and administrative rules and regulations.

Orientation shall be considered as an ongoing process for all School Board members, and may include such activities as those indicated above and the addition of items such as these:

1. Attendance at School Board and administrative conferences and conventions on a local, area, state, and national basis.
2. Exchange of ideas through joint meetings with neighboring school boards.
