

B-8 BOARD MEMBER QUALIFICATIONS

Board members must be at least voting age, eligible to vote, and reside within the boundaries of the Plainfield Community School Corporation. Notwithstanding, any other statute or applicable law, school board members need not reside for a longer period than two (2) years in the state and one (1) year in the school corporation immediately before their taking office by appointment or election.

Candidates for election to the Board of School Trustees must file a "Declaration of Candidacy" with the Clerk of the Circuit Court under the same statute as the filing for candidacy of other offices elected during the general election.

Board of School Trustees members need to have a general interest in and devotion to public education, a willingness to give time and effort to the work, a capacity for understanding people, and the ability to work cooperatively with others.
