

C-10 SCHOOL BUILDING ADMINISTRATION

Acting with the approval of the superintendent and upon the advice of central office administrators, principals shall be the chief administrators of their schools. All personnel assigned to a building shall be directly responsible to the principal of each school in which they work during the time they are working there.

The principal is charged with the supervision and direction of the staff and the students assigned to the building, and with care of the school facility and its equipment. He or she shall see that the rules and regulations of the district, the directives of its officers, and the guidelines for the instructional program are observed. Within the framework of the policies of the Board and the general rules and regulations set by the superintendent, the principal may establish and enforce such regulations as he or she deems advisable for the efficient operation of the school.
