

## **D-22 SCHOOL PROPERTIES DISPOSAL PROCEDURE**

The governing body of a school corporation acting on behalf of the school corporation has the authority to sell or exchange any of the real or personal property or interest therein which in the opinion of the governing body is no longer necessary for school purposes, or demolish or otherwise dispose of such property if in the opinion of the governing body it is worthless and pay the expense of such demolition or disposition. The sale, transfer or lease of such property must follow the procedure outlined in state law.
