

## **E-15 SCHOOL BUS SAFETY PROGRAM**

The safety and welfare of student riders shall be the first consideration in all matters pertaining to transportation. Emergency evacuation drills shall be conducted regularly throughout the school term to thoroughly acquaint student riders with procedures in emergency situations.

All vehicles used to transport students shall be maintained in such condition so as to provide safe and efficient transportation service with a minimum of delays and disruption of such service due to mechanical or equipment failure. Buses shall be replaced at such intervals so as to provide good equipment at all times. To help keep the Board members fully informed regarding the status of the bus fleet, the assistant superintendent shall annually prepare a School Bus Replacement Plan as part of the annual budget process.
