

E-17 SCHOOL BUS MAINTENANCE

The school buses shall be repaired and maintained in such a manner to insure maximum serviceability to the district and the utmost safety for the passengers and in accordance with state codes and regulations.

Each school bus shall be inspected by the driver daily, before use, to ascertain that it is in safe condition, equipped as required by all provisions of law, and that all equipment is in good working order.

The Indiana State Police shall annually inspect all school buses to determine whether each school bus complies with the safety requirements prescribed for school bus construction and equipment in the official rules and regulations of the state school bus committee.

A program of preventive maintenance shall be in force for all school buses. Maintenance records and cost of repairs and operation shall be kept for all school buses by the Director of Transportation.
