

G-12 STAFF GIFTS AND SOLICITATIONS

GIFTS TO STAFF MEMBERS

Students, parents, and other patrons of the school corporation shall be discouraged from the routine presentation of gifts to employees.

When a student feels a desire to present a gift to a staff member, the gift shall not be elaborate or unduly expensive.

The Board shall consider as more appropriate than gifts the writing of letters to staff members expressing gratitude or appreciation.

This shall not be interpreted as intending to discourage acts of generosity in unusual situations, and simple remembrances expressive of affection or gratitude shall not be regarded as violations of this rule.

SOLICITATIONS BY STAFF MEMBERS

No staff member shall use his or her position in the Plainfield Community School Corporation to influence parents or students to purchase books or other merchandise, except for materials approved by the superintendent or principal for use in the classroom. No staff member shall have the right to solicit funds nor sell merchandise in the school nor to the public for neither the school nor any school activity without permission from the building principal.
