

I-10 PROGRAMS FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

All school age students in the legal settlement area of Plainfield Community School Corporation, including students with disabilities and children ages 3-5 with identified disabilities under Article 7, Rules 32-47 (Hereafter referred to as Article 7), shall be provided a free and appropriate public education as described in Title 511 Indiana State Board of Education Article 7.

Students are identified as in need of special education services through the referral, intervention, evaluation, and placement procedures as outlined in Article 7.

DEFINITION:“Special Education” means specially designed instruction, provided at no cost to the parent to meet the unique needs of a student identified as disabled in accordance with Article 7. Special education may include the following:

1. Instruction conducted in:
 - a. The classroom
 - b. The home
 - c. Hospitals and other institutions
 - d. Other settings
2. Instruction in physical education
3. Travel training
4. Transition services
5. Vocational education
6. Speech-Language Pathology services
