

## **I-41 STUDENT PROGRESS REPORTS TO PARENTS**

The Board of School Trustees requires that all parents be informed at regular intervals on the progress of their students in school. The superintendent shall establish means through which this will be accomplished.

The Board also encourages the administration and staff to work together to improve methods for evaluating student's progress and develop more meaningful ways to report achievement to parents.

The purpose of reporting is to:

1. inform parents of the progress made by their students
2. bring parents into a closer understanding of the work of the school
3. record for students their success or achievements
4. help students evaluate their own progress
5. help the student, parents, and teacher work cooperatively for improvement

Student Progress Reports will be sent to parents following the end of the grading periods indicated on the school calendar.
