I-51 Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Section 504)

Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, (hereafter referred to as Section 504) prohibits any entity receiving federal funding to banish students on the basis of disability from any aspect of their operations. Where Plainfield Community School Corporation Community School Corporation is concerned, those operations involve the education of children and the employment of a work force.

Therefore, it is the policy of the Plainfield Community School Corporation not to discriminate against any otherwise qualified individual with a disability, solely by reason of his/her disability, in admission or access to, or treatment or employment in any program or activity sponsored by the school corporation.
