

I-9 SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONAL PERSONNEL, PROGRAMS, AND ACCOMMODATIONS

PERSONNEL

Director of Special Education

Directs and coordinates programs for students with disabilities in the corporation.

School Psychologist

Provide psycho-educational evaluations to students on a referral basis as indicated in Article 7 Rule 40, 511 IAC 7-40-1 through 511 IAC 7-40-8

Speech Language Pathologist

Employed for the purpose of providing speech and language therapy to students and providing required hearing evaluations as identified through screenings and referrals as indicated in Article 7 Rule 41, 511 IAC 7-41-8.

Autism Consultant

The Autism Consultant is employed for the purpose of providing consultation and training to staff who educate students with an Autism Spectrum Disorder.

Preschool Coordinator

The Preschool Coordinator is responsible for supervising the evaluation and identification of students ages 3-5 who qualify for Special Education Early Childhood services as identified in Article 7 Rule 41 511 IAC 7-41-6. The Preschool Coordinator is also responsible for the development of programs for Early Childhood and for coordinating Case Conference Committee Meetings.

ALPHA

ALPHA is an inter-local agreement between Avon, Brownsburg and Plainfield Schools to serve students with severe Emotional Disabilities as identified in Article 7 Rule 41, 511 IAC 7-41-7. Students with severe emotional disabilities who cannot be supported in their home school district may attend ALPHA if that placement is determined by the local district in a case conference committee meeting.

PROGRAMS FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

Definition and Overview

The operation of programs for special needs students is governed by federal law and state regulations. The Indiana Department of Education and the Office of Special Education monitors the local education agencies for compliance with the Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act (IDEIA) and with Article 7, the Indiana Regulations for Special Education Programs and Services. The U.S. Department of Education's Office for Special Education and Rehabilitation Services (OSERS) is responsible for monitoring Indiana's compliance with IDEIA.

Article 7

Article 7 is the name of the document containing the special education rules promulgated in Indiana Administrative Code at 511 IAC 7-32 through 7-47.
