

## **J-16 STUDENT DRESS CODE**

Students of the Plainfield Community School Corporation shall dress and groom themselves in an appropriate manner. The responsibility for the appearance of the students rests with the parents and the students themselves.

A student's dress and appearance should not be disruptive to the educational process, constitute a threat to the safety and health of the student or others, not be in violation of any statute, or be considered distracting, indecent, or wholly inappropriate for the classroom.

If a student's mode of dress or grooming is unacceptable within the broad limits as stated, the principal or his or her designated representative should:

1. Discuss with the student those areas of attire or grooming that need to be improved.
2. Schedule a conference with the parents to inform them of those problem areas of attire or grooming which have not been corrected.
3. Suspend the student from school if the style of dress or grooming continues to be unacceptable within the limits as defined by the building principal. Repeated violations (non-compliance) could lead to expulsion.
