

J-30 INOCULATIONS OF STUDENTS

The Board of School Trustees requires when a student enrolls for the first time that the parents furnish a written statement of the child's immunizations, accompanied by the physician's certificates or other documentations, and testing history. The statement shall show, except for a child covered by IC 20-8.1-7, section 2 (religious objection) or 2.5 (child's health), that the child has been immunized in accordance with state law and/or Indiana Department of Health regulations. The statement shall state the date he or she received each immunization. No child shall be permitted to attend school for more than twenty (20) days beyond the date of his or her enrollment without furnishing this written statement. However, if the local health department or a physician determines that the child's immunization schedule has been delayed due to extreme circumstances, and that the required immunizations will not be completed before the twentieth day, the parent of the child shall furnish this written statement and a time schedule, approved by a physician or the local health department, for the completion of the remainder of the immunizations. In this case, the child may attend school.

Failure to comply with the immunization law requirements is grounds for exclusion from school.
