

## J-38 STUDENT BICYCLE USE AND AUTOMOBILE USE

### BICYCLES

When safety conditions permit, bicycles may be ridden to school. Bicycles are to be parked in designated racks at all times while school is in session.

### MOTOR VEHICLES

Indiana law has delegated school personnel the authority to regulate the operation of motor vehicles on school property. Any violation of these rules may result in the revocation of a student's driving permit.

1. Requirements for permission to operate a motor vehicle on school property:
  - a. All students operating a motor vehicle on school property during regular school hours must obtain a Parking Sticker from the proper administrative office for each vehicle he or she intends to operate.
  - b. All students operating a motor vehicle on school property must have a signed permission from their parents.
  - c. All drivers must possess a valid operator's license.
  - d. All vehicles must be properly licensed.
  - e. Students agree to abide by all school rules and Board policies.
  
2. Driving regulations:
  - a. No speeding, dragging or reckless driving is permitted.
  - b. Driving on the south side of the school is limited to direct routes to and from assigned parking spaces.
  - c. Drivers should not arrive at school prior to 7:15 a.m.
  - d. Upon arrival at school, students are to proceed directly into the building. Loitering in cars is not permitted.
  
3. Miscellaneous
  - a. No individual may drive a motor vehicle on school property other than the one registered on the permit.
  - b. All motor vehicles must display a current parking sticker.
  - c. All motor vehicles must be parked in their assigned parking areas only.
  - d. School personnel will assume no responsibility for the security of a student's vehicle.
  - e. Vehicles improperly parked or not registered may be subject to tow-in without notice at owner's expense.
