

J-41 EMPLOYMENT OF STUDENTS

Students desiring employment outside of school and between the ages of 14 and 17, are required by the state to have an employment certificate issued by the principal's office prior to the beginning of work.

Each applicant shall be required to provide the following before being issued a certificate.

1. Proof of age - birth certificate
2. Proof of schooling
3. Proof of prospective employment -- written statement from the person who plans to employ the student. This is called the "Intent to Employ" card and may be obtained at the principals office.

Students seeking employment shall be subject to the requirements of state law.
