

## **J-42 STUDENT GIFTS AND SOLICITATIONS**

### **GIFTS TO STUDENTS**

Students are warned against receiving gifts from solicitors or outside organizations. Students participating in high school sports shall refrain from accepting any type of gift. For further information, students should consult the high school principal concerning rules of the Indiana High School Athletic Association on this matter.

### **SOLICITATIONS OF STUDENTS**

The Board of School Trustees shall strive to safeguard the students and their parents from money raising plans of outside organizations, commercial enterprises, and individuals.

This policy applies particularly to ticket sales and sales of articles or services except those directly sponsored or handled by the school authorities.

Outside organizations shall not be permitted to use students to sell tickets at school except those jointly school -sponsored or school-approved parent/teacher activities.

Business representatives or salesmen shall not solicit or interview pupils during the school hours on school property except with administrative approval.

Any charity fund drives must be approved by the school principal.

The taking of photographs of students at the school building, under school authority for the purpose of their sale to students is permissible if approved by the principal.

### **SOLICITATIONS BY STUDENTS**

Teachers, students, student groups, and other employees shall not have the right to solicit funds nor sell merchandise in the school, nor to the public for the school, nor for any school activity without permission from the building principal.

All publicity concerning any phase of the school activity fund drives which will appear in the newspaper or other media source must be cleared with the school principal. Publicity concerning the school district or for all schools, must be cleared through the superintendent.
