

K-13 VISITORS TO THE SCHOOLS

The Board of School Trustees encourages visits by citizens, taxpayers, and parents to any or all of the school buildings within the Plainfield Community School Corporation. The Board urges local taxpayers to visit the school facilities and to observe the quality of education offered within the district; determine its needs; and to join with the Board in improving the system. The Board also believes that the parents of students attending the schools have special rights and responsibilities in addition to those of taxpayers generally to keep themselves informed as to the day-today operation of the schools.

Visitors are asked to proceed first to the school office. These visitors may include parents of pupils, interested citizens, invited speakers, maintenance and repair people, salesman, representatives of the news media, students not now enrolled in school, and others.

All visitors during school hours are requested to register in the school office and receive administrative approval for visitation.
