

L-1 EDUCATION AGENCY RELATIONS GOALS

The Board of School Trustees recognizes the important contributions made by other organizations and institutions that exist within the community. It believes that much is to be gained through cooperative endeavors with other agencies.

In order to make a maximum contribution to education, within the school district and to other educational agencies, the Board of School Trustees establishes these broad goals:

1. To encourage liaison with other educational and noneducational agencies.
2. To supply educational services to and/or share with other educational and noneducational agencies.
3. To recognize the significant role of the local, county, and national parents associations or organizations, and solicit the support of these organizations for better education at the local, state and national levels.
4. Cooperate with, and be vitally interested in, the problems of school boards of other districts, the Indiana School Boards Association, the Indiana Department of Education, the National School Boards Association, and the United States Office of Education.
